### Athletics

The varsity swim and dive team wrapped up its' season over the weekend at the state championship, finishing 9th out of 51 teams. The Hawkeyes were led by All-State performances from Carson McIntire in the 200 freestyle, where he finished 6th, and the 400 freestyle relay team of McIntire, Trey Nyboer, Justin Stark, and Jack Langeland, who also finished 6th. The 200 yard medley relay team of Landen Maatman, Owen Lewis, Langeland, and Nyboer took home a 9th place finish, Langeland finished 11th in the 200 freestyle, Stark finished 27th in the 200 IM, Jackson Miller finished 10th in diving, Langeland finished 12th in the 100 butterfly, McIntire finished 14th in the 500 free, Nyboer finished 19th in the 500 free, the 200 freestyle relay team of McIntire, Stark, Lewis and Nyboer finished 9th, Maatman finished 21st in the 100 backstroke, and Lewis finished 29th in the 100 breaststroke. A special congrats to Carson McIntire who broke school records in both the 200 free and 500 free over the weekend.
