## **MARCH 2022**

DIT meeting was held on 3/15/22. The following agenda items were discussed:

#### **Celebrating District Accomplishments**

- Donations to PBIS stores, student of the month celebrations at MS and HS
- Ability to add progress monitoring for students in 5th and 6th grade
- Use of behavior data to create action plans to support students
- Planning for Student Council and Support Classes at the High School
- March is Reading Month Activities
- Parent participation at Elementary Parent Teacher Conferences
- Improvement in Elementary reading scores from fall to winter and schoolwide efforts to support reading progress

#### **Addressing Barriers to Successful MTSS Implementation**

- Staffing and recommended group sizes are causing a subgroup of students who would benefit from intervention possibly not able to receive it at the Middle School
  - Plan: Intervention staff meeting to determine plans for next year. Regrouping initial subcommittee to problem solve around programs, group sizes, and staff
- Inconsistent tracking of parent communication
  - Plan: Explore options within our current systems to track parent communication
- Schedule changes at the High School have reduced opportunities for teaching PBIS Expectations
  - Plan: School Leadership Team meeting to discuss options
- Planning for Reading Interventions at the High School
  - Plan: Currently reviewing assessments that will provide us more information about the skills struggling high school readers need to work on
- Questions about how to adapt and differentiate within the confounds of sticking to fidelity of our core reading curriculum
  - Plan: Administrative staff engaging in listening tour to hear about teacher concerns with implementing curriculum and our schedule

#### **Subcommittee Updates**

- Student support team at the High School Planning for additional course options to support students next year
- High School Reading Intervention Committee piloting assessment to target intervention needs
- High School ELA will be participating in interviews to determine implementation of Secondary Literacy Essentials
- Vocabulary Subcommittee bringing in teachers for a work day to define consistent expectations for teaching vocabulary
- Elementary Tier 3/3 Behavior expanding methods for tracking student progress in interventions and tracking our fidelity of implementing interventions
- Elementary Tier 3/3 Reading revising our processes for tracking student history of intervention and reviewing pilot programs used for 3rd and 4th grade
