Celebrating District Accomplishments

- Middle School is finding ways to connect with students "in the middle" 405 students have been connected within 3 weeks
- Middle School store is going well- students are saving tickets for "good" prizes
- Middle School using Classroom of the Week to focus on specific expectations
- High School retaught expectations after Thanksgiving break and is teaching lessons throughout the year
- Tier 3/3 teams meeting monthly at all levels
- MS and HS teachers seeing more value in recording student behavior data
- Students making progress on Check in, Check Out Intervention
- Elementary making revisions to Major/Minor behavior consequences processes

Addressing Barriers to Successful MTSS Implementation

- Keeping PBIS stores stocked
 - Plan: Donations, budget-funded purchases, utilizing raffles and experience-based items
- Implementation of Okay2Say program
 - Plan: Middle School staff and student committee forming to look at how to revamp this program
- Teacher participation on DIT
 - Plan: Require teachers to attend a shorter time period of the meetings to coincide with planning and provide a stipend
- Procedures for students not making academic progress
 - Plan: Subcommittee forming to address meeting, action planning, and documentation procedures
- Process for parents to request help for their children
 - Plan: Drafting an informational procedure document
- Math expressions program out of date
 - Plan: Committee forming to evaluate options
