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Mi Kids Back on Track (23g)

According to MCL 388.1623g(13), the purpose of MI Kids Back on Track is to support programs designed to:

- Address unfinished learning.
- Get students to grade-level academic standards.
- Provide additional academic standards.
- Provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers.
- Help high school students prepare for postsecondary education.

Program Purpose: to engage our most at-risk students with additional resources to support their learning, boost academic skills, and focus on age-appropriate social-emotional learning.

Program Summary: To that end, Hamilton Community Schools will commit all of the State allocated 23g funds, with the direct intention to mitigate learning loss via the following: Implement evidence based practices to meet the comprehensive needs of students using the subgroup formula (ESSER III Template) for all students lagging in academic performance and run a robust summer school, inviting students who need to catch up to their peers and move grade level academics.

- HCS will use funds to expand/enhance evidence based practices in tier 1 instruction, tier 2 instruction and tier 3
 instruction. This includes maintaining and training (where needed) certified staff, as well as specialized staff, to carry
 out all three levels of instruction (Tiers 1-3)
- Primary use of funds will be to Implement evidence based practices to meet the comprehensive needs of students
 using the subgroup formula (ESSER III Template) for all students lagging in academic performance
- The HCS 23g budget includes a comprehensive formula as prescribed in ESSER II & ESSER III related to learning loss
