

#### BARRIERS

- Are all staff members aware of what the DIT does and decisions we make?
  - Action Plan: Share DIT update will all teaching staff monthly
- Identifying students to participate in an AP Seminar
  - Action Plan: HS and MS staff will meet to determine entrance criteria for succeeding in AP courses
- Behavior in Young 5s and Kindergarten
  - Action Plan: Adding to the input we gather prior to students starting Kindergarten, looking in to Tier 1 instructional resources, shifting staff to support where data indicates a need
- Behavior Management in Before and After School Care
  - Action Plan: providing training to Hawkeye Kids staff
