LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Deconstruct 1950s classroom wing
- Construct 8-classroom addition including Special Education and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)
- Replace classroom casework and counter tops as needed
- Update finishes, flooring, and hardware as needed
- Multi-purpose room/gym finish upgrades
- Purchase classroom furniture for new classrooms
- Upgrade and move playground equipment
- Purchase educational technology as needed

- Opened in 1952

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
