

On May 2, 2023 our community will vote on a school bond proposal. If approved by voters, this bond would provide \$41,180,000 to address safety and security, facility infrastructure, and learning environments.

SAFE, DRY, WARM

- Roofing improvements
- Electrical, mechanical, and plumbing upgrades
- Exterior insulation and finish system (EIFS) at north and south entrances
- Glass security film for main building vestibule
- Replace classroom door hardware for improved safety
- Kitchen upgrades
- Replace aging school buses

LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- Classroom casework and counter tops as needed
- Replace multi-purpose room/gym flooring and ceiling
- Replace ceilings as needed
- Playground equipment upgrades and additional fencing
- Purchase educational technology as needed
- Restroom upgrades
- Replace lockers as needed

- Opened in 1954

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
