Picture Day is coming on Thursday, Oct. 6. Order forms were sent home with all students earlier this week. Pictures can be ordered online or by returning this form on picture day.

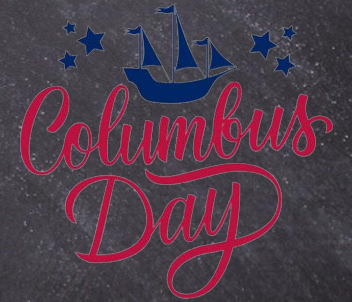
