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DIT meeting was held on 1/18/21. The following agenda items were discussed:

Celebrating District Accomplishments

- Middle school has used department chair meetings to keep teachers informed and provide them with the tools they need to support their department.
- Middle school reviewed school wide expectations with a schoolwide game and is utilizing student of the month and classroom of the week initiatives to support reinforcement of the schoolwide pillars.
- Middle school has been providing reading and math interventions and reviewed data and groups this winter.
- High school acknowledgement and PBIS instruction up and running. The buckets used for the acknowledgment system were designed by a student.
- A team and Honor Roll celebrated 376 high school students' accomplishments
- Sandyview: Staff discussion of consistent consequences and response after a student receives a behavior referral. Parent member on the SLT.
- Bentheim: celebrating reading growth on winter testing. Parent member on the SLT.

Addressing Barriers to Successful MTSS Implementation

- Keeping PBIS stores stocked
 - Plan: Donations, budget funded purchases, utilizing raffles and experience based items. Fundraising committee to look at who and how often we are asking for donations
- Implementation of Okay2Say program
 - Plan: Middle School staff and student committee forming to look at how to revamp this program
- Management of Tardies at the Middle School
 - Plan: High school shared their procedures for tardies with middle school administration
- Curriculum alignment 7-12
 - Plan: Schedule opportunities for departments to meet with middle and high school staff
- Processes for students not making academic progress
 - Plan: Subcommittee meeting in February

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Subcommittee Updates

- Tier 3/3 Behavior Teams are meeting at all levels to discuss options for behavior interventions, procedures for requesting assistance, and monitoring student progress.
- Tier 3/3 Academic Teams are reviewing progress and feedback from fall interventions.
- New Subcommittees Forming: Elementary Math, Vocabulary, and Intensive Academic Needs.



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
