Another great week under our belts! And the sunshine was perfect this week. I sound like a broken record, but your kids are simply amazing. Thank you for sharing them with us.


This week we learned all about the word 'stealth'. Ask your child what the word means. Do you remember reading the word 'stealth' in Charlotte's Web?




